- Teabags
- Rice, pasta, bread, and cereal
- Egg and nut shells
- Dried and cut flowers



#### You CANNOT Compost

- Meat, fish and bones
- Cheese and dairy products
- Fats, grease and oils
- Plastic, metal, glass or foil
- Produce stickers
- Bags of any kind
